

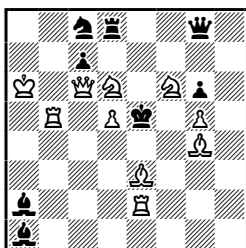
Aleksander Guliajew (Grin) (1908 – 1998)

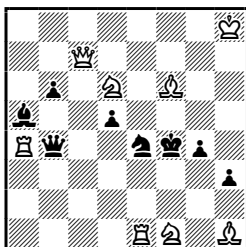

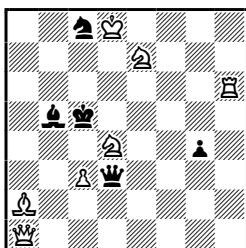

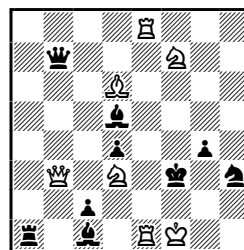

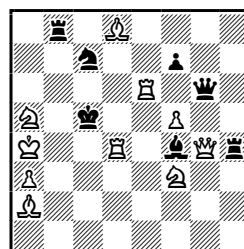

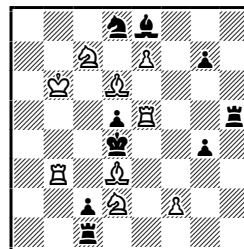
