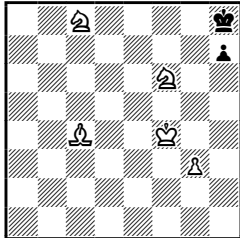

Le Palamede, 1837

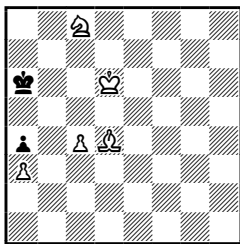

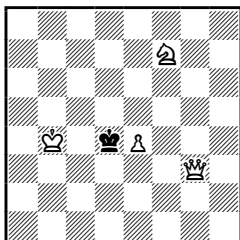

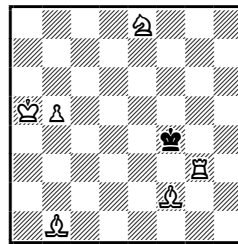

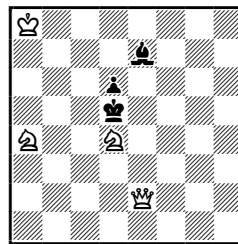
